Bromley's Local Plan – Statement of Community involvement Consultation

We are revising the Council's Statement of Community Involvement (SCI). This document outlines the Council's standards for community participation in the planning process and identifies the ways we will achieve these standards. Since it was first adopted in 2006, there have been changes to the planning system and technological advances that enable new consultation techniques, so we have updated the SCI in the light of these changes. To ensure the changes to the Revised SCI are appropriate to local needs we are consulting on the proposed Draft Revised SCI for six weeks from **9th February to 23rd March**. Please tell us what you think.

You should find that the Consultation Portal at www.bromley.gov.uk/localplan is the quickest way to tell us what you think. Once registered, you will automatically receive an email when we publish any new Local Plan consultation document.

You do not have to register to view documents on the consultation portal, although you do if you wish to comment on line. If you have registered, or think you have and you have forgotten your 'User Name' and/or 'Password', once on the consultation portal, please follow the instructions under 'Login/Register' at the top of the Portal pages.
